



Dear guests with dogs

A WARM WELCOME to the PRINZ-LUITPOLD-BAD

We want both you and your four-legged companion to feel completely comfortable during your stay. We kindly ask for your understanding and cooperation in observing a few rules for dogs in our hotel:

1. Please use your own food bowl, not hotel dishes. Feeding should take place in your room or on the balcony. **Animals are generally not allowed in the restaurants.**
2. Your loyal companion should have their own place where they can rest undisturbed. Please keep hotel beds and seating areas free of pets.
3. Since all dogs – no matter how well-behaved – instinctively defend their territory, please hang the "do not disturb" sign on your door. This will prevent our housekeeping staff from being startled. To ensure the cleaning of your room, please arrange a fixed time with our team.
4. The Bad Hindelang region is home to many rare animals and plants. This preservation is made possible by landowners who carefully manage the area through forestry, hunting and above all, sustainable farming. Dog waste in the pastures poses hygiene issues and more importantly a serious health risk to cattle.
5. Please take your dog for a walk outside the hotel premises. In designated "roby-dog" stations provided by the municipality, you will find waste bins and dog waste bags. These bags are also available for free at the reception and the guest information center.
6. Flower beds and the sunbathing lawn at the outdoor pool are also not allowed for dogs.

Dog waste stations with bag dispensers are located at:

Bad Hindelang: Near the Sparkasse bank; at the beginning of the footpath from Jörg-Lederer-Straße to the protestant church; at the entrance to Hirschbachwäldchen (near the mini-golf course); and at the all-weather sports field.

Bad Oberdorf: At the entrance to Schanzpark; Eisenhammerweg bridge at Wildbach; Hirschbachweg chapel; directly at the entrance to our parking lot; and below the hotel at the access point to the krof-course.
